4210 MATTERS RAISED BY MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC. Further incidents involving quad bikes, and between walkers and members of the local Shoot in Wadworth Woods, were reported. It was felt there was a lack of understanding as to what is the current progress between Doncaster Council and the wood owners. The Chair stated he would report the incidents to the Wood owners and also contact the Shoot. He would also include an article on the footpaths matter in the forthcoming newsletter.

4212 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

- a. **Play area security (4199b).** No further progress, still awaiting advice from Doncaster Council. It was reported that in accordance with the Public Space Protection Order, dogs must be kept on a lead whilst on the playing field.
- b. **CCTV update (4199c).** Members agreed in principle that a village CCTV installation would be desirable, however Cllr Greenhalgh reported that schemes being developed in neighbouring parishes were not yet mature enough to assess their financial viability.
- c. **Newsletter update (4202e).** A draft had been produced and the final version was to be produced and distributed in the next two weeks.

- e. **To discuss the village maypole.** Two responses had been received to requests to re-paint the maypole. **Resolved: it was resolved to award the contract to Bagnalls. The quote was lower than the grant received and the Clerk was to enquire whether the balance of the grant should be repaid.**
