3937 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE. Apologies were received and reasons accepted from Cllr S Booth.

3939 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST. Nil.

3940 CASUAL VACANCY – TO ELECT A NEW COUNCILLOR

Lesley Slack was the only nominee for the vacant position and informed members of her wish to be elected. Proposed and seconded by Cllrs Oliver and Fromont. Vote: Unanimous.

Resolved: it was resolved to elect Lesley Slack to Wadworth Parish Council and fill the casual vacancy.

3941 MATTERS RAISED BY MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

a. Access gate to Sports Field – it was requested some sort of gate be installed to the sports field entrance to Church Lane as a safety measure to prevent children and dogs running on to the lane. The council promised to consider the request and look at options.

3942 MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 10TH JANUARY 2019 – the minutes were accepted as a true and accurate record and signed by the Chair.

3943 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

a. **Allotment update (3929a/3934a). HELD IN PRIVATE SESSION (SEE ITEM 3948a BELOW)**

- b. **Play equipment update (3929b).** Members were advised installation of the new equipment was scheduled for the week commencing 25th March 2019. Prior to this date the old equipment was to be disposed of locally. Tickhill and District Lions have given a donation to the Parish Council towards the project and a bench to the value of £473.58 plus VAT had now been ordered. A letter of thanks had been sent to the Lions Club.
- c. **Car park markings (3929c).** Car parking bays were planned to be marked out on Osberton Street around 1st March 2019.
- d. **lport Planning Application Update (3929d).** The lport plans were to be viewed on the lport site in the near future (exact date tbc).
- e. **Dog bins update (3929e).** All requested dog bins had now been installed. Item closed.
- f. **To consider speed sign options 3932a).** DMBC had provided 3 potential locations for the installation of signs, all of which were acceptable. Costs for installation on these sites were required. Cllr Leaney had obtained four quotes for signs, of which the one provided by Elan City was considered the best. As this company appeared to be fairly new to the market however, references were required before this quote would be considered the preferred option.

3944 WARD MEMBER UPDATE. Members were advised that St Leger Homes were soon to tarmac the car park at the top of Church View, and there had been a recent spate of break-ins at local churches.

Concerns regarding potential traffic issues had already been raised but there were no further details at present.
- e. **To discuss the wall to the rear of the Village Hall.** The council had been

advised that a wall to the rear of the Village Hall was felt to be in a dangerous condition. Ownership of the wall was, however, unclear at this stage and needed to be confirmed.
