### Matters Raised By Parishioners

1718. The earlier allotment proposal has now formally been submitted, members raised no objections, but the changes to be subject to a rolling 6 month notice period.

### Village Improvements

1721. The pavilion roof has now been completed, Members asked that an electrician look over the electrical system to determine safety and compliance with current legislation.

### Matters Arising From The Minutes

1722. Members have gained further details about the TARA group, the group was formed with the help of Ledger Homes The group covers all residents in Wadworth, minutes are available . The group accessed diversionary funding from the police to engage and provide activities over the Halloween period. The main concerns are anti-social behaviour, housing issues and the Osberton Street play area. Mr Stevens commented that the TARA more closely represents the half of the village behind the shops whilst it is perceived the parish council more closely represents the remaining half of the village. Members disputed this, stating they are there to represent the whole village.

### Planning Matters

1723. The Government Office Of Yorkshire & The Humber has responded to the request to consider the Inland Port application at a public enquiry. It appears the application has been held in abeyance as some issues have not been fully addressed. Further communication will be received from the office in due course.
