### Matters Raised By Parishioners

1194. Mr Webb raised the issue of flood drainage and fencing in the Ratten Row area. A meeting had previously taken place with DMBC and Ledger Homes, but no conclusion had been reached. Clerk to request updates from DMBC Councillor Hoyle.

1195. Mr Webb also raised the issue of alterations to the bungalows, the program has subsequently been cancelled by DMBC. The residents have raised a petition, but no further updates have been given by DMBC as to the reinstatement of the programme. Clerk to request updates from DMBC Councillor Hoyle

1201. The allotment tenancies have now been resolved and only one allotment is now vacant.

1202. The clerk reported issues with the drainage on some of the allotments and near to the gate. Members decided to keep the matter under observation.

1203. Mr Kerns gave an update on the progress of the petition of youth facilities in the area. It appears parishioners are only happy to sign the petition if the facilities are to be behind the pavilion, other sites may not receive parishioner support. There are currently over 40 signatures on the petition, this is currently being split by age group. The petition is continuing and it is hoped to be presented at the next parish council meeting

Mr Kerns & Mr Harris left the meeting at 7.30pm

1204. The Countrywoman's association will not be planting the troughs as in minute 1153. They have started to plant around the grassed area of the community centre.
