1842. Apologies for Absence

Matters Raised By Parishioners

1843. Messer's Skinner, Knight and Oliver raised concerns regarding the proposed new sports area to the rear of the pavilion. All are strongly opposed to the proposal on the grounds of increased youth nuisance, noise and the fact that such a facility is not required in the area. Members explained that the proposed land is DMBC land and that DMBC, at the last attended parish council meeting, had not decided whether to support the scheme. The parish council has also not decided on the scheme and is awaiting further information and the public consultation which will happen if the scheme progresses further than the idea, which it currently appears to be. It was noted that access, other than pedestrian, would need to be across the playing field, which is owned by the parish council

1844. Messer's Skinner, Knight and Oliver stressed that they wished to raise the strongest possible objection to the scheme and asked the parish council support them in this matter.

1845. The parish council noted that serious consideration would be given to the matter once the scheme became a serious proposition. A request is to be made to DMBC for further details on the proposal and if the Neighbourhood team could attend the next parish council meeting. Any update to be forwarded to Mr Skinner.

Messer's Skinner Knight and Oliver left the meeting at 7.25pm

1846. Mr Stevens asked about the church clock, an estimate to repair has been requested from the PCC

Neighbourhood Team Report

1847. A report was forwarded and read to the meeting, it noted that the bunding on Toffield Road is being repaired and expected to be complete in the next few weeks. The new dog fouling signs have been ordered and will be installed as soon as possible.

1848. An increase in dog fouling along Short Gate to be reported to DMBC.

Police Report

1849. No report has been received from the police. DMBC member to pursue the matter of non communication

1850. There has been an increase in burglaries in the parish and the surrounding areas. Police have been increasing activity and arrests have been made.

Matters Raised by DMBC Members

1851. DMBC are to donate £2000 towards the community centre repairs, WCCA to contact DMBC to arrange the funding contract

1852. Members noted the bench, currently stored in the pavilion is beyond economic repair and asked if a replacement could be considered at the forthcoming DMBC survey of seating.

1853. The bridge between Rossington and Wadworth is to be considered at a meeting at the end of June. funding to replace it is not currently available. Letter to be forwarded to Councillor Roe

1861. The WCCA have requested permission to hold a car boot sale on the playing field. It was noted that car parking on the roads around the playing field would need to be managed.

1862. A site meeting is to be arranged with DMBC to discuss the trees on Church Lane and the snicket off New Tree Drive.

1863. Councillor Wright forwarded an update from the TARA meeting. It is unlikely the gateing order for Green Lane will be agreed.. Smart Water is still available from DMBC. There is no funding for additional litter bins. Police at the meeting stated that speeding traffic in the area is not the problem it is perceived to be. It is hoped the Mayor will attend the next TARA meeting.

1864. Members noted that the position on burials and christenings needed to be clarified. matter to be added to the next agenda.

Financial Matters

1865. The annual return was accepted and authorised to be signed by the Chairman

1866. The Governance Statement was accepted and authorised to be signed by the Chairman

1867. The membership renewal for RAY was agreed.

1868. The proposal to donate £1000 for community centre repairs was agreed.
