### Matters Raised By Parishioners

1873. Mrs Graham raised the matter of the proposal to restart mining in the area near the village. plans have been seen and various presentation days are being arranged in nearby areas. It was noted that several residents are worried by the proposals and that it may cause issues with buildings insurance. Mrs Graham noted that the level of existing subsidence in the area is to be benchmarked by an independent third party to enable assessment of any future claims for subsidence. There is also concern about vehicles and any temporary access roads that may be built. It was noted from the plans that there appeared to be no protection for the church, but that the school and Wadworth Hall appeared to be protected.

1874. A public meeting is to be arranged with the company undertaking the mining. it is understood that the mining cannot be stopped. but that a consultation with the villagers should be undertaken.

### Matters Arising From The Minutes

1875. The haulier responsible for replacing the seat on Tofield Road has undertaken to replace the seat within the next four weeks.

1876. The poplar trees have been inspected by DMBC and found to be in a stable condition. if they are lopped. they will grow faster. Members to meet with the affected parishioner to determine the best remedial action to be taken.

1877. DMBC have provided an estimate for the work needed on the trees around the pavilion and the snicket leading to New Tree Drive. The estimate was accepted and the work to be undertake at the earliest convenience.

### Neighbourhood Team Report

1878. Mr Eardley had received some crime statistics for the area. the main point to note was that burglaries had fallen from 5 reported incidents in the previous month to 1 this month, although in addition to this there has been a report of a theft from a vehicle and 4 other crimes. Members noted that there has been a recent break in and a vehicle has been stolen. It is believed a number of arrests have been made in surrounding areas.

1879. St Ledger Homes are to visit the area with the Connections vehicle during the summer holidays, provision has been made for three visits.

1880. The issue of the grit bin has been passed to the Highways department for assessment, but it has been confirmed that there will be no new bins until the winter season.

1881. The damaged bench has been agreed as un-repairable, the site to be added to the bench survey being undertaken by DMBC.

1882. DMBC have noted No further progress on the proposed games area behind the pavilion. Residents to be advised

1883. Members asked if there was any progress on the TARA initiative to provide a skip. DMBC were unable to comment.

1884. The bunding on Tofield Road has been completed.

1885. It was noted that TARA has been awarded funding for further community activities.

1886. DMBC asked that the WCCA be prompted to contact them regarding the devolved budget funding agreed for disabled access at the centre.

1887. At a recent DMBC meeting regarding the missing bridge, the general consensus was that the bridge should be replaced, but there is as yet no funding to do so.
